Appointments required for On-site and Montana Health Center flu shots.

Flu Shots at Montana Health Centers

- Helena, Billings, Missoula, and Miles City
- October-November (while supplies last)
- State Plan members 4-years-old and older
- Ask for your flu shot when you come in for any other scheduled Health Center service or make a flu shot appointment*
 1. Log into www.carehere.com
 2. Click “Appointments-SS” on the left hand menu
 3. Select “Flu shot” under “What”
 4. Follow the rest of the on screen instructions to make your appointment

¹ The seasonal influenza vaccine often protects against more than one strain of the virus and is different each year based on projections for illness-causing strains. We recommend that you ask what the provider/pharmacy will charge the plan and choose your best option from there.
