Schedule your State-sponsored health screening at a Montana Health Center OR at an [off-site event](#).

PLEASE NOTE: If you need to add a A1C, TSH, or PSA, you must bring a prescription/doctor's orders with you to your appointment. No other tests can be added to off-site screenings. If you are attending a screening at a health center, you may be able to add other lab (blood) tests with a prescription.

You must have an appointment to have a State-sponsored health screening:

- Log in at www.carehere.com.
- First time making an appointment with CareHere—register with access code MANA9.
- Select "Blood Draw" next to "What."
- Select "Off-site Health Screenings" **OR** the Health Center of your choice next to "Where."
- Select the **exact date** or date range of the screening you want.

*All health centers are accepting appointments any time that works for you – but please schedule your screening now! **Last day to have a health screening to count towards an incentive to begin on January 1, 2018 is October 31, 2017. A health screening is required to earn ANY [incentive](#).**

The State Plan offers the incentive program to all plan members and their enrolled spouse/domestic partner. If you think you may be unable to meet a standard of the incentive program, you may qualify for an alternative program or different means to earn the incentive. You must contact the Health Care & Benefits Division (HCBD) as soon as possible at 800-287-8266 or email livelifewell@mt.gov. We will work with you (and if you wish, your doctor) to design a program with the same incentive that is right for you. Any personal medical information gathered during the course of the incentive program is protected by and will be treated consistent with the HIPAA Privacy and Security Rules.
