

## **Breast Pump Coverage**

Standard (non-hospital grade) or manual pumps are covered one time per birth event. Rental of hospital grade pumps is covered when medically necessary. Remember, breast feeding/lactation support and counseling is covered after the birth of the child while at the hospital or as part of the office visits that occur after the child's birth. Additional lactation consultation can be claimed under your flexible spending plan. *Lactation consultants can help you make the best use of your pump or recommend what type might work best for you. The intake associate will ask you some questions (health plan ID, address, what kind of pump you want, etc.). **If you want specific features (such as a 2 mode stimulation/expression speed) or a specific brand, you will need a prescription from your doctor.** Your doctor can fax such prescriptions to Care Centrix at 877-301-5330.
