Primary Care vs. Urgent Care vs. Emergency Room

Choosing the right health care setting for your health condition or concern helps you get the right level of care faster, avoid unnecessary costs, and make the most of your State Plan benefits.

Primary Care Provider

Your First Stop for Most Health Needs

Your primary care provider knows your health history and is the best place to go for:

- Routine checkups and preventive care
- Ongoing conditions like asthma, diabetes, or high blood pressure
- Non-urgent concerns about your health

Why choose primary care? Primary care is typically the most affordable option and helps you build a long-term relationship with a provider who understands your overall health and is available when something arises you need care for.

Find Primary Care on the State Plan: The Montana Health Centers offer <u>no-cost</u> <u>primary care</u> or use the BlueCross BlueShield of Montana <u>provider finder tool</u> to locate in-network primary care in your area.

Urgent Care Center

When You Need Help Quickly (but it's not an emergency)

Urgent care centers are great for issues that need attention quickly but aren't life-threatening. Visit urgent care for:

- Sprains, strains, or minor fractures
- Flu symptoms, fever, or sore throat
- Minor cuts or burns
- · Ear infections or sinus issues

Why choose urgent care? They offer extended hours, same day availability, and lower costs than the ER.

Finding Urgent Care on the State Plan: The Montana Health Centers offer no-cost <u>virtual telehealth appointments</u> 24/7 from anywhere in the U.S., some same day appointments at the <u>Montana Health Centers</u>, or find an in-network urgent care facility using your BCBSMT's <u>Blue Access for Members</u> online account.

Emergency Room

For Serious or Life-Threatening Situations

The ER is the right choice when you're facing a medical emergency. Go to the ER for:

- · Chest pain or difficulty breathing
- Severe bleeding or major injuries
- Sudden numbness, weakness, or confusion
- Possible stroke or heart attack
- Any situation where you feel your life or health is in immediate danger

Why choose the ER? It's equipped for the most serious conditions and provides immediate, advanced care but it's the most expensive way to access care.
